

## **WPS Website Architect's Report May 2015**

The new website went live in August 2014.

Steve Green lead the team which drew up the specification. The team included David McKibbin, Graham Barber, Gerard Carlin and help from David Taylor. Gerard Carlin was asked to design and build the Website.

Since then the top five most popular areas of the Web site, up to 5<sup>th</sup> May 2015 are:
