2. Minutes of AGM held 14th May 2013 were accepted.

3. Matters Arising The new constitution discussed at the last AGM was adopted at a SGM on 21st May. The election of Louise Brown as vice president was agreed at a meeting on 15th October 2013

4. Treasurer's Report See separate report.

Graham took questions and comments on the limit to the number of members, average membership fees and possible concessions on fees, the need to spend money on a new lap-top, and various details of the accounts. He will look into getting higher interest rates on WPS savings. (**Action:** Graham)

Ann Erkut is taking over as secretary. He thanked members for their support over the (almost) eight years he has been in office.

6. Programme Secretary's Report. Tony outlined next season's exciting programme, with 10 speakers, including several outstanding ones including Brian Griffin. **Action:** David McKibbin is to cover this role for the start of next season.

7. Competition Secretary's Report – including external competitions. See separate report. It was suggested that the judging order in competitions (Beginners, Intermediate, Advanced) is varied to allow more visibility of advanced entries. **Action:** Gordon will consider options for better display of Advanced members entries. More informal evaluations of pictures for beginners were also discussed.

8. Exhibition Coordinator's Report. See separate report. The quality of the PDI display in the exhibition and opening night was thought to be poor. **Action:** Simon will address this for next year's displays

9. Reports from other officers. Workshops (Chris Gillard) Chris thanked the speakers throughout the year, and said that two workshops (Lightroom and Portraits) had been "sellouts" and encouraged members to submit ideas for future workshops.
